

2 TIMOTHY STUDY

Background

The apostle Paul wrote this letter to his disciple Timothy in the mid AD 60's from prison in Rome. "Second Timothy is a bold clear call for perseverance in the gospel in spite of suffering. Paul calls on his young coworker to continue the fight of faith, even as Paul approaches the end of his own life."¹

Instructions

1. Each day's reading has two parts: a longer passage to read and a shorter passage to study.
2. When studying the verses, state the facts, ask and answer questions, form principles and applications, and respond in prayer.
3. After each chapter, summarize what you've learned under these categories: title, theme verse, and key principles.
