## **CO THE GOSPEL OF MARK**

"This Gospel conveys, then, something important about Jesus. He is not merely a historical figure, but a living reality, a person who addresses us today...Mark wants us to see that the coming of Jesus calls for decisive action...Therefore we can't remain neutral. We need to respond actively." - Tim Keller

## **Background**

The Gospel of Mark, written between 65-70 AD to the church in Rome, was probably the first Gospel to be written. John Mark, who accompanied Paul and Barnabas on their first missionary journey (Acts 12:25), is believed to be the author. Mark shows identity of Christ as King over all (chapters 1-8) and the purpose of Christ's death (chapters 9-16). Likewise, the study focuses on the person and work of Jesus in order to apply the principles learned to our lives and ministry.

## Instructions

- 1. Each day's reading has two parts: a longer passage to read and a shorter passage to study.
- 2. When studying the verses, state the facts, ask and answer questions, form principles and applications, and respond in prayer.
- 3. After each chapter, summarize what you've learned about the person and work of Jesus and Jesus' discipleship of the Twelve.
